# **VARIETY OF MASSAGE HEADS**



#### Flat Head:

is a mid-intensity massage that localize the massage and can be used mid to large muscles.



#### **Ball Head:**

is a mildest massage option, designed to massage the large muscles groups.



#### **Bullet Head:**

is a highly concentrated massage intended to be applied to pressure points, pinpoint tight muscles and ligaments around the joints.



#### Fork Head:

is a concentrated massage designed to target the near the spine.

### **OPERATION**

To initiate the use of the massage tool, switch the button located on the bottom of battery handle to the ON position.

Then located back of the massage tool press the center button and light will appear and the massage head will be activated.

Press the button again to increase the strength of the massage. There multiple settings for the intensity.

To stop the massage press and hold down the button until the massage tool turns off. The light on the massage tool should be off to indicate the massage tool is in the OFF setting.

When charging the battery, the battery light will flash. Once the unit is fully charged the light will stay solid.
